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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS for JKST07R and JKST07RB



HARDWARE KIT:

- 1– Step Assembly
- 1- 5/16" nutsert
- 1- 5/16" x 1 Bolt
- 1- 3/8 nut
- 1-5/16 flat washer
- 2- 1/4"x3/4" Bolts
- 2- 1/4" Top-loc nuts
- 4- 1/4" washers
- 2-5/16" pins

Please read and understand all instructions before beginning the installation of the Hide-A-Step. Please read the terms and policies on the back of these instructions.

This step mechanism uses a very strong spring. Extra care should be used during installation and use to prevent injury to fingers and hands!

The JKST07R is designed to fit the following Jeep® vehicles: 2007 to current JK Wranglers. The step is designed to work along with or without the factory Rubicon rock rails. The step may interfere with other factory installed or aftermarket steps or rocker guards. The step may also interfere with aftermarket lower control arm mounts on the outside of the frame. The step is designed to be quick detachable by removing two pins.

STEP 1: If your jeep has factory installed Rubicon rock rails, Remove the entire Rubicon rail. (see picture 1) If your Jeep does not have rocker guards proceed to step 2

STEP 2: Install the Hide-A-Step over the single stud to the front side of the two studs. (see picture 2). Mark and drill 9/32" hole in the pinch seam, using your step as a template. (see picture 3)

STEP 3: While the step is mounted on the factory stud, mark the top hole of the step mount for the nutsert. Remove and drill 17/32" hole (for the nutsert) into the floor pan. (see picture 4)

Step 4: Insert the nutsert into the 17/32 hole. Slip the supplied 3/8" nut over the 5/16" x 1 bolt and tighten the bolt into the nutsert which will crush the back side of the nutsert, crimping it in place. (see picture 5)




STEP 5: Install Hide-A-Step over factory stud. Insert the 1/4°x3/4° bolts with washers through the pinch seam. Install washers and nuts onto these bolts. Install 5/16°x 1 bolt and flat washer (FW) up into nutsert. Tighten all Hardware.

STEP 6: Line up the holes in the step and insert the two pins to complete assembly (see figure 4)

STEP 7: The step has raised dimples to provide traction but care should be taken during use to prevent slippage. Mud, ice, and snow may make the step slick. You are now done so **GO JEEPIN!**

Use this stud for one of the Mounting points. Drill 9/32 hole for the 2nd mounting point in the pinch seam using 1/4" x 3/4" bolt, FW and nut.


