## **Bracket Installation**

1. Decide the location where you want to run your wires for your light
  - a. Recommend running the wires down the length of the bracket and into the hood seam to the engine compartment
  - b. Other possibility is through the rubber seal in the front door
2. Run your wiring harness for your light as you attach your brackets
3. Remove the factory bolts from the A-Pillar on both drivers and passenger sides



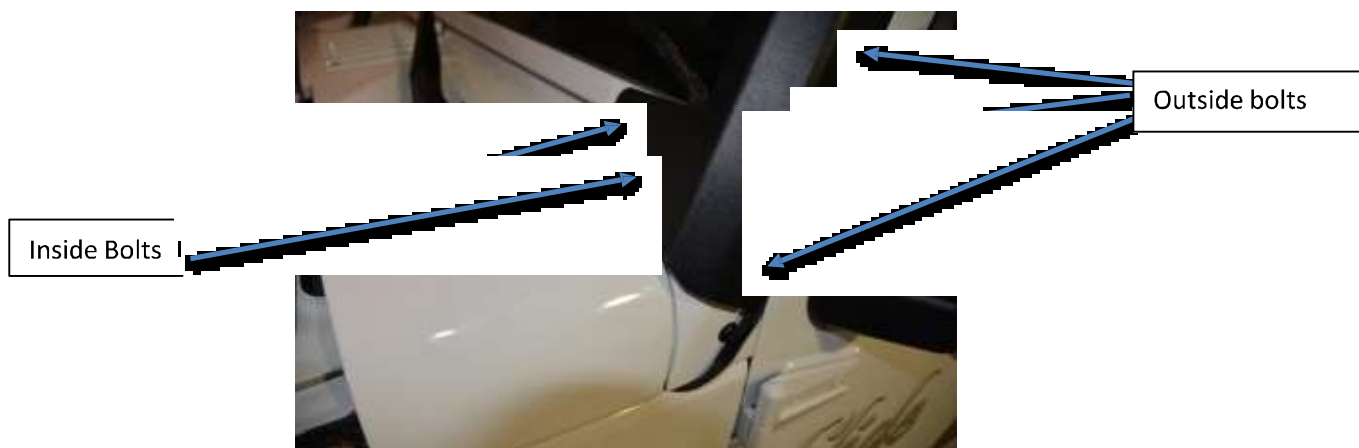
4. Nylon washers are provided to keep the bracket off of the paint. The washers can be used one on each bolt, or if you need more space to run your light wires, you can stack more washers on one bracket to create space for your wiring.
5. Run the flange head bolt through the bracket and attach a nylon washer. Do this for each bolt in the bracket



6. Set the bracket against the A-Pillar with the bolts held into place with the washers. Make sure if you have wiring, it is located where you want



7. Start the tightening sequence with the outside 3 bolts. Tighten them loosely then move to the inside 2 bolts. The inside bolt holes have a slot to allow for the bracket to move as to tighten the bracket



8. Alternate tighten from the outside holes to the inside holes until the bracket is tight against the A-Pillar
9. Repeat steps 5-8 for the second bracket
10. Ensure all bolts are fully tightened before installing the light bar
11. Install the light bar onto the brackets. The mounting holes allow for different sizes of mounting bolts. Use appropriate washers and spacers to ensure the light bar is secured safely to the brackets. The brackets can be tightened to pull them close together for a snug fit with the light bar. If necessary, the A-Pillar bolts can be loosened before tightening the light bar to create more space. After the light bar is tightened snugly to the top of the brackets, re-tighten the A-Pillar bolts.



Ensure light bar is securely attached with appropriate washers, spacers, etc

12. Attach wiring to switch and power source
13. Enjoy!
