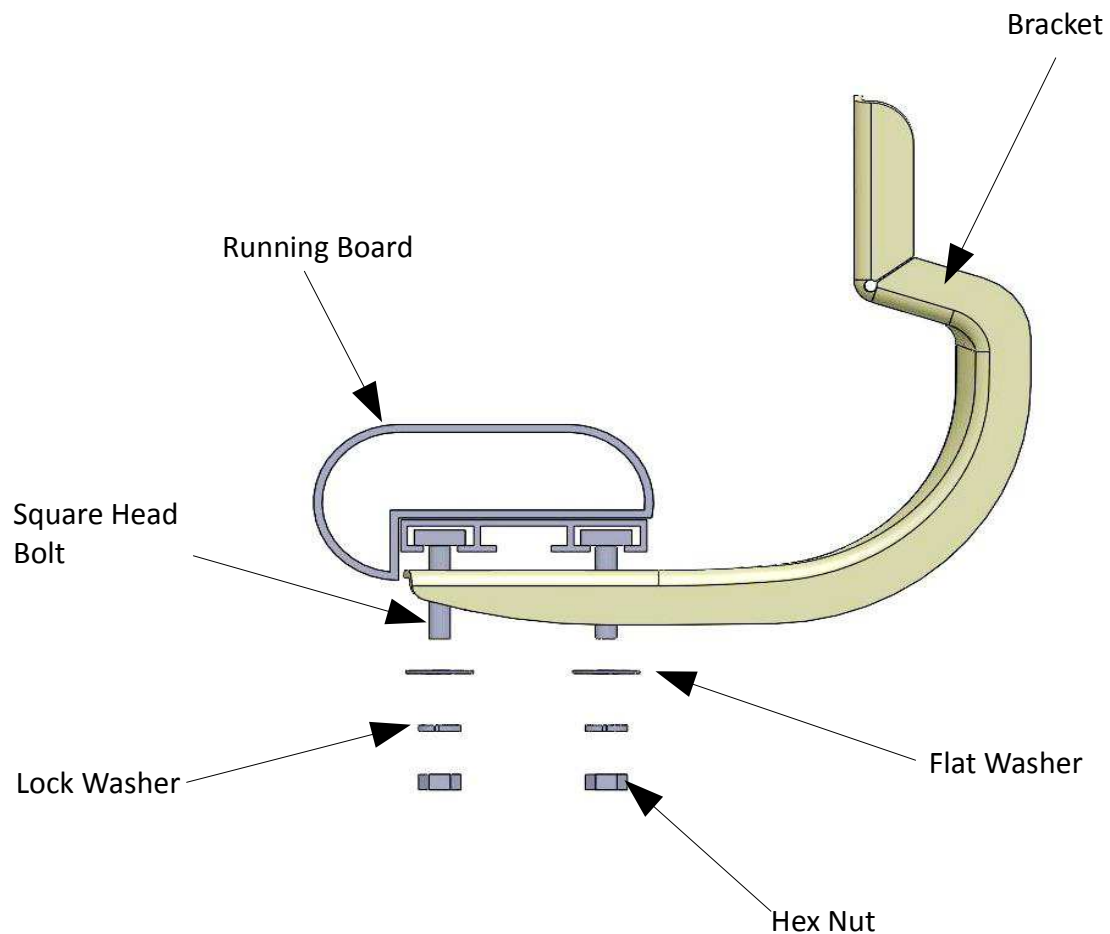
Required Tools:

x1 Ratchet

x 1/2" Socket

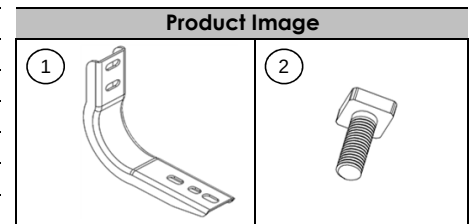
Steps:

1. Install the brackets (sold separately) on the vehicle.
2. Insert the Square Head bolts (Included on the brackets kit) on the rails as shown on illustration.
3. Locate the obrounds on the bracket and place the bolts inside.
4. Place Flat Washer, Lock Washer and Hex nut (included on the bracket kit).
5. Align and adjust the running board.
6. Tighten all the Hex Nuts.

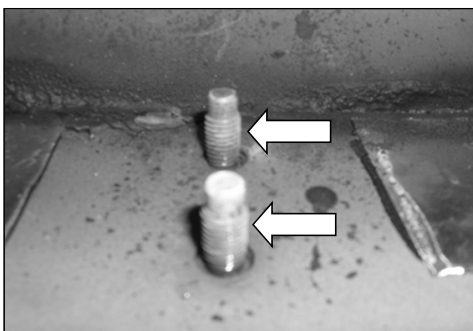

Instructions

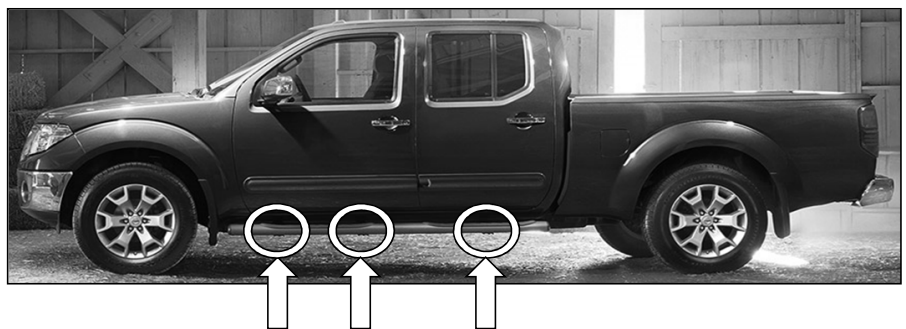
- Before beginning the installation, please read all directions carefully and verify that all necessary hardware is accounted for. If any parts are missing, stop the installation and contact your distributor immediately.
- To maintain and care this product keep it clean and do not use abrasive cleaners or polish waxes. We recommend to use only non-abrasive automotive wax such as pure carnauba to avoid scratches and rust.
- The approximate installation time is 45 min.
- Locate below in the rocker panel, in the sides, spiral per us to the front, center and rear of vehicle. **SEE PICTURE 1 & 2.**

Threaded studs to install each of the brackets.

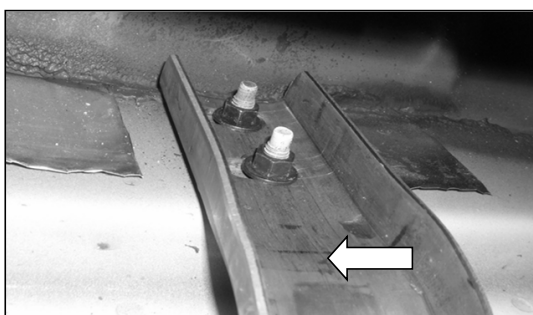

In this part, under the vehicle install the driver side front, middle and rear bracket.

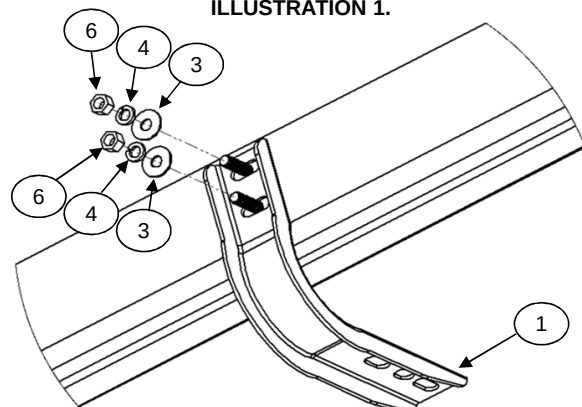
- Install the brackets on threaded stud to the front, center and rear of vehicle and attach with (2) nuts M8, (2) flat and lock washer 5/16". Leave loose. **SEE PICTURE 3 & ILLUSTRATION 1.**

6.- If you acquired a 5" or 6" COMPOSITE Side bar, insert 5/16" square head bolt on rail, place on brackets and attach with: 5/16" Flat and lock washer, 5/16" hex nut. **SEE ILLUSTRATION 2.** Repeat for the opposite side. Leave loose.

7.- If you acquired a 4", 5" or 6" Black or Stainless Steel side bar, place on brackets and attach with: 5/16" square head bolt, 5/16" Flat and lock washer. **SEE ILLUSTRATION 3.** Repeat for the opposite side. Leave loose.

8.- Align the side bar and then tighten all bolts.

9.- Periodically check your product because it may need a re-tighten of bolts.

10.- Fill the warranty card and place it inside your vehicle's glove box.

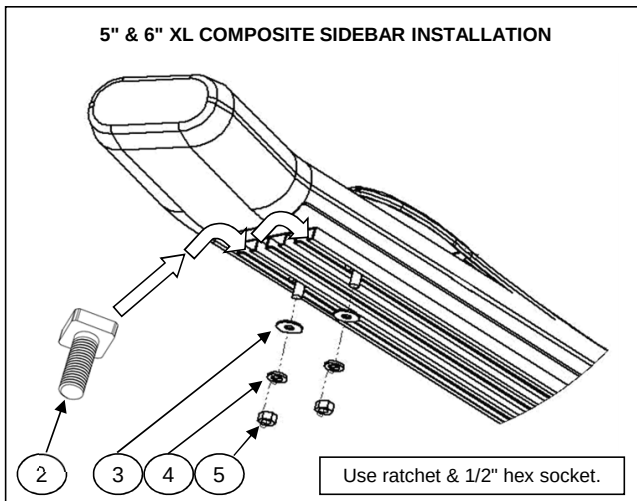
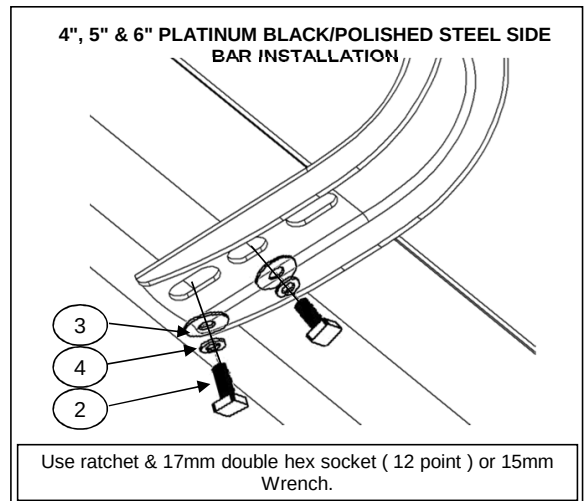
