



#### **PROCEDURE**

1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.



- 2. Starting at the front passenger side, remove the factory bolts shown in Figure 1 and loosely install the Front Mounting Bracket (1) using two M8 hex head bolts (3), two M8 lock washers (5), and two M8 flat washers (4). See **Figure 1.**
- 3. Move to the center of the vehicle and loosely install the Center/Rear Mounting Bracket (2) using the same hardware as listed in **Step 2**. Move to the rear of the vehicle and repeat. See **Figure 2**.






- 4. Attach the running board to the installed mounting brackets by sliding three M8 square head bolts (6) into each of the outer slots in the bottom of the running board. Align the bolts with the corresponding holes in the mounting brackets and attach using six M8 flat washers (4), and six M8 nylon lock nuts (8). Do nut fully tighten at this time. See **Figures 3 & 4.**
- 5. Adjust running boards as needed and tighten all hardware at this time. Tighten all M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs.
- 6. Repeat Steps 2-5 for drivers side of the vehicle.
