

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING PICTURES ARE BASED ON THE DRIVER SIDE INSTALLATION

STEP 1


Starting on the Driver/Left front of the vehicle, remove the plastic plugs, (or hex bolts), covering the threaded holes in the body panel, (Fig 1).

STEP 2




(Fig 2) Attach Driver/Left Front Mounting Bracket to the front mounting location

Select the Driver/Left Front Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the vehicle with (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Fig 2). Do not tighten hardware at this time.

STEP 3




(Fig 4) Driver/Left rear mounting location

Move along the body panel to the center and rear mounting location, (Figs 3 & 4). Select remaining (2) Driver/Left Center/Rear Mounting Brackets. Repeat Step 2 to install the Mounting Bracket on center and rear mounting locations, (Fig 5). Do not tighten hardware.



(Fig 3) Driver/Left center mounting location

(Fig 5) Attach Driver/Left Center/Rear Mounting Brackets to the center and rear mounting locations

STEP 4

Select the Driver/Left Running Board. **NOTE:** The Driver/Left Running Board will have a "**307L**" on the front. Carefully place Running Board on the brackets. **IMPORTANT:** Do not slide the Running Board front to back or damage to the finish may result. Attach Running Board to the (3) Mounting Brackets with (6) 8mm Combo Bolts, **(Fig 6)**. Do not tighten hardware.

STEP 5

Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 6

Repeat **Steps 1—5** to attach the Passenger/Right Running Board.

STEP 7

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Running Board.
