




(Fig 1) Starting on Passenger Side wheel well, remove three screws and two plastic clips to release the liner from the front clip. Pry tool may help with separating liner from front clip. Repeat for Driver side. Be sure to retain all hardware.

Follow Fig 1-13 to carefully remove Front Clip from vehicle. Refer back to these Figures for reinstalling the Front Clip.

(Fig 2) With a pry tool, carefully pull the fender flare outwards to release it from the side. Repeat on Driver side.



(Fig 3) Remove screw attached to side of front clip behind fender flare.



(Fig 4) Remove air dam from front clip by removing several screws from underneath on each side.



(Fig 5) Continue removing air dam by removing several screws from underneath at the center. Keep hardware in safe storage.



(Fig 6) Remove (2) factory bolts to loosen bottom section of front clip. Keep hardware in safe storage.



(Fig 7) Remove factory bolt to loosen side bottom section of front clip. Keep hardware in safe storage.



(Fig 9) After removing plastic covers and air intake, remove three bolts holding the upper clip.




(Fig 8) Open the hood and remove plastic covers and air intake by unfastening clips and bolts. Plastic pry tool may help with removing plastic clips.



(Fig 10) After removing plastic covers, locate wire harnesses for shutter and camera on each side.




(Fig 11) Unplug passenger side wire harnesses shown




(Fig 13) Carefully release and pull the front clip off the vehicle and place it on a flat secure surface. Remove the plastic piece from the crash bar and place it aside.




(Fig 12) Unplug driver side wire harnesses shown




(Fig 14) On back side of the Front Clip, locate and remove front bumper plastic.




(Fig 15) If parking sensors are equipped, temporarily unplug them. Unclip the panel using a pry tool by pushing on small tabs for each retainer along the panel.




(Fig 16) Locate and remove 10 small screws holding the panels.




(Fig 18) Trace and mark along inner profile to ensure accurate cutting lines. The upper edge line is measured at 1" above the bottom profile line.




(Fig 20) After marking cut line, use trimming tool and cut along the line starting at one of the ends. Be sure to move any wiring clear of the cutting area.




(Fig 17) Front bumper plastic removed.




(Fig 19) The top edge cutting line should be 1" away from the bottom edge profile.




**(Fig 21)** Front clip after trimming. Reinstall the upper panel equipped with parking sensors.




(Fig 22) On Driver Side, remove two upper frame horn bolts from crash bar. They will be reused to mount bumper bracket. Repeat step on Passenger Side.



(Fig 23) Remove two lower frame horn bolts from crash bar. They will be reused to mount bumper bracket.




(Fig 24) Position mounting bracket upper slots on crash bar and fasten using upper crash bar bolts that were just removed.



(Fig 25) Position mounting bracket lower slots on crash bar and fasten using lower crash bar bolts that were just removed. Repeat steps to mount bracket on Passenger Side. Be sure to only work on one side at a time to avoid risk of damage.



(Fig 26) Test fit the bumper and adjust any brackets for proper position before reinstalling front clip onto vehicle. The brackets will be difficult to adjust with the Front Clip on. When ready, refasten reinstall the Front Clip and all upper, side, and bottom screws and clips that were previously removed.




(Fig 27) Apply Edge Trim by clamping from the bottom side, continuing along the top, and ending at the opposite side end. This will protect the Factory Plastic against thin edges. Cut any excess trim with a metal cutter.

(2) 8-1.25mm x 25mm Hex Bolts (4) 8mm x 24mm x 2mm Flat Washers




(Fig 28) Install LED light bar at center cut out at this time if using. Use LED Light Bar specific hardware to mount to bracket. Follow LED Light Bar's instructions to set up wiring to vehicle.




(Fig 29) If using Center Mesh Plate, attach Center Mesh Plate using indicated hardware.


- (2) 8-1.25mm x 20mm Hex Bolts
- (4) 8mm x 16mm x 1.6mm Flat Washers
- (2) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts



(Fig 30) Install Bull Nose at this time if using. Refer to indicated hardware to secure both ends onto the bumper.




(Fig 32) With assistance, lift and position bumper onto front clip, lining up bumper slots to mounting bracket slots. Hold the bumper in position, then insert indicated hardware to mount the bumper. Do not tighten completely at this time. Repeat on other side.



(Fig 31) Insert Rubber Plugs into holes if Bull Nose will not be installed.




(Fig 33) When the bumper is positioned properly, tighten the hardware completely from the opening on outer side.



(Fig 34) Install mesh plates using indicated hardware and hex wrench.



(Fig 36) Installation is complete. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.



(Fig 35) Insert Plastic Plugs into square slots in center of bumper to install License Plate
