





PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Starting on the driver side of the vehicle, locate the mounting locations with factory bolts preinstalled in them. Remove the factory bolts from the threaded holes. See **Figures 1 & 2** for reference. *Note:* The factory bolts will not be reused.
- 3. Locate (1) Driver Front Mounting Bracket (Item 2) and loosely install it to the driver front mounting location on the rocker panel using the supplied M8 hardware (Items 10-12). See **Figure 3** for reference.









- 4. Locate (2) Driver Center and Rear Mounting Brackets (Item 3) and loosely secure the brackets onto the driver center and rear rocker panel mounting locations with the supplied M8 hardware (Items 10-12). See **Figure 4** for reference.
- 5. Repeat **Steps 3 & 4** for the passenger's side mounting locations with the Passenger Side Mounting Brackets (Items 4-5). *Note:* See *Figures 5 & 6* for the correct bracket orientation.




Note: Crew Max Pro-Traxx Step Bar is Shown in Figures 5 & 6, Double Cab Bracket Orientation is Similar.



- 6. Use the supplied M6 Hardware (Items 7-9) to attach the Bracket Covers (Item 6) to the corresponding Mounting Brackets. See **Figure 7** for reference.
- 7. Use the supplied M10 Hardware (Items 13-15) to loosely secure the Pro Traxx 4 Step Bars (Item 1) to the corresponding Mounting Brackets. See **Figure 8** for reference.
- 8. Align and adjust the Pro Traxx 4 Step Bars and Mounting Brackets as necessary. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft-lbs, M8 to 17 ft-lbs, M10 to 38 ft-lbs.




